RULES OF ENTRY/ ELEGIBILITY

The Haitian Music and Art Festival will take place at Pompano Citi Centre in Pompano Beach Florida (Copans & Federal Highway). The event is open to all artists. Space is limited by category. Limited number of likes per category.

MEDIA

All artwork must be produced by the artist. Mass produced commercial items will not be accepted. The right is reserved to disqualify any participants selling items deemed inappropriate.

PHOTOGRAPHS

Applicants must submit one photograph to display an example of their work. It will not be returned. Photographs must be labeled with artist name and type of media. The right is reserved for the photographs to be use in publicity.

COMPLIANCE

Photographs submitted must be representative of the artist to be exhibited and sold. Any booth exhibiting work not created by the artist may be asked to remove those items.

FEES

The \$50 artist fee and \$25 non-profit fee will reserve a spot within the show. Artists will be required to supply their own tents, tables & displays. Tents should be 10 x 10 and white.

You will be assigned a booth tent space which you will receive a few days prior to the show. Set-up begins at 8 a.m. Parking is free in one of our many surface lots. There will be no reassigning of booth spaces on the day of the event for any reason. If you have a pressing request to be next to someone in particular, please make that known on your application when registering. If you require electricity, you must request it on you application. Booths with electricity are limited and will be distributed on a first come, first served basis.

POLICIES

Please submit the application, fee and photos as soon as possible. First come basis. Please send the photos with your application and Hold Harmless.

Professional looking booths. No tape, no handwritten signage. ETC.....Professional signs created by a sign company, need referrals? Please ask!
